The Andrew and Dorothea Perenchio Museum Studies Intern program at Fresno State is offering a paid internship to a student (undergraduate or graduate student) to work as an art intern with Nancy Youdelman to assist in the preparation for an exhibition of Youdelman's artworks at the Fresno Art Museum.

Art Studio Intern:

The candidate for this position will assist the artist Nancy Youdelman while she prepares for a retrospective exhibition that will take place in the summer of 2017 at the Fresno Art Museum. The candidate will help the artist pull artwork out of storage, locate artwork owned by collectors, organize artworks by decade, do minor repairs under the artist's supervision, add artworks to a database as an inventory of all the artwork that will be included in this exhibition and help prepare the artwork for exhibition.

Good written and communication skills are essential. Some physical work is required. The candidate should have a strong working knowledge of Photoshop, Microsoft Office and be able to work on an iMac. Ten hours per week, days are negotiable but mornings are best. This internship may be applied for 3 units of credit (Art 198) at Fresno State, grading will be Credit/No Credit.

Application:

Submit a letter of intent explaining how your skills fulfill the internship requirements and a statement describing why you are applying for the internship; together with a list of Art courses taken and the names of two faculty references to the Art Office by Friday October 23, 5pm – attention Andrew and Dorothea Perenchio Museum Studies Interns program coordinator. An interview will be required – this will take place at the Fresno Art Museum on Friday, October 30, 2015.

Funding:

The Perenchio Endowment provides funding and administration of the internship. Fresno State oversees course enrollment and credit. Nancy Youdelman oversees the work of the intern in her studio while the Fresno Art Museum oversees Youdelman's exhibition.
