
CALL FOR PAPERS

Deadline: Thursday, February 27th, 2025

Maximum length: 3,000 words Recommended Length: 1,500-3,000 words Eligibility: Current Fresno State student

Topic: Any topic in philosophy, religious studies, or peace and non-violence studies. This may be a topic addressed in a term paper from a PHIL or PAX course, but you can also write a new paper for this event. If you do, we recommend that you get some input from one of your professors about it. If selected, you should be able to present your paper in 25 minutes.

Anonymous review: Mention your name and the professor, if any, who supervised or commented on your work <u>in your email message only</u>.

Please remove all identifying information [name and course info] from the paper, including from footnotes, the file name, and document properties [in **WORD**: File/Info/Inspect Document/Remove Document Properties and Personal Information].

Cover page: Please provide only the following information on your cover page:

• Paper Title

• Area [Philosophy/Religious Studies/PAX]

• Word Count

Submission: Electronic. Papers must be received by email by 11:59 PM on 2/27/2025.
