Acting Audition Guidelines:

- You will have up to four (4) minutes to perform your audition package.
- Prepare two (2) contrasting monologues.
- Songs are acceptable in lieu of one (1) monologue. A piano will be provided but you **MUST** bring your own accompanist. We will also provide a speaker with headphone jack.

Video Submission Guidelines:

- Videos show NOT exceed 4 minutes
 - Video should be recorded from the waist up, in a well-lit and quiet room. Video should be filmed in landscape (horizontal) format.
