Dance Audition Guidelines:

- You will have 2-3 minutes to perform your dance piece.
- You will be evaluated in terms of technique, memory, timing, and stage presence.

Video Submission Guidelines:

- Videos should NOT exceed 3 minutes.
 - Video should be recorded so your full body can be seen, in a well-lit and quiet room. Video should be filmed in landscape (horizontal) format.
