What Do You Prepare?

- Be ready to answer the following questions:
 - o What past experiences have you had in the design/tech area for theatre? (if you have a resume, we'd love for you to submit it.)
 - o Why are you interested in the design/tech emphasis for Theatre Arts?
- Although it is not required, you may bring examples of any work you have done that might be related to Design/Technology:
 - o **Production Work:** woodworking, scenic painting, flat building, sewing projects, light hanging, sound recording, prompt books, projections, etc.
 - o Design: photographs, models, renderings, drawings, sketches, clothing, sound mixing, etc.
 - o **Artwork:** sketch books, paintings, collages, sculpture, ceramics, photography, computer illustration, films, etc.
 - DIY Projects: Upholstery, sewing projects, woodworking, decorating, craftwork, electrical wiring, etc.
- Design emphasis students will also be encouraged to participate in design workshops offered in the afternoon.
